RW 1/24 ELECTION OF CHAIRMAN

It was proposed by Cllr Withams, seconded by Cllr Fabb and unanimously **RESOLVED** to elect Cllr Potts as Chair to Rights of Way Committee for the remainder of the municipal year.

RW 2/24 APPOINTMENT OF VICE CHAIR

It was proposed by Cllr Land, seconded by Cllr Sproats and **RESOLVED** to elect Cllr Fabb as Vice Chair to the Rights of Way Committee for the remainder of the municipal year, replacing Cllr Wyatt.

RW 3/24 WELCOME

Chair Potts opened the meeting.

RW 5/24 MEMBERS' INTERESTS

Cllr Cole declared a pecuniary interest in agenda item RW 7/24, Footpath 4, due to it running across her property.

RW 6/24 MINUTES OF 6th FEBRUARY 2023

It was proposed by Cllr Withams, seconded by Cllr Cole and **RESOLVED** by all Members present, the Minutes of the meeting held on 20th March 2023 be signed as a correct record by the Chair.

RW 7/24 MAINTENANCE OF RIGHTS OF WAY

Appendix 1 includes a list of all Footpaths & Bridleways

Members, K Simpson and R. Reeves discussed maintenance updates and historical background on the footpaths and bridleways within the Parish;

1. Humberdale way

No maintenance required.

2. George Lane/Third Avenue

No maintenance required.

3. Woodlands to Highway (Now Footpath 20)

No maintenance required. Historically there have been investigations with Cambridgeshire County Council (CCC)to lengthen the route.

4. Coronation Avenue to flaxen walk

Pathway across the field requires improvement as many parents use it as a safer route for school children. Previous investigations had been completed by Cllr Cole to add a permanent pathway to her land, but the Council were still awaiting approval via CCC as they had received the money from the developers towards the work (£12,000). Clerks to follow up with CCC contact, J. Stringer for progress report.

5. Airfield

No maintenance required. It was noted that the route signpost was down and it was pointing in the wrong direction.

6. Crossing A141 via Wilthorne

No Maintenance required. It was noted that the safety signage was approved and awaiting installation by CCC.

7. Station Road to Pingle Wood

Cllr Fabb declared a pecuniary interest at this point due to it being alongside land he owns. Cllr Fabb currently maintains the hedgerow along the route to improve vision for walkers. It was also noted that the CCC approved 40mph buffer zone signs which should be installed soon.

8. Woolvey Farm, A141

Needs hedgerow cutting back urgently before nesting commences. Clerk to instruct handymen.

9. Fenside Road to A141

No maintenance required.

10. A141 linking footpaths to Pidley

No maintenance required.

11. Wistow Toll to Wistow Fen Lane

No maintenance required, but it was noted that it is not easily accessible.

12. Humbrills Farm

It was noted that paddocks had been built over the pathway, but the owners won't pay to divert. Now there is a permissive pathway along the perimeter.

13. A141 to Rowey Farm

Nothing to report.

14. Bridleway - Millers way, Puddock Road to Bridleway 17 Nothing to report.

- 15. Bridleway Cross Drove Nothing to report.
- 16. Bridleway 1st Turf Fen Road Nothing to report.
- 17. Bridleway 2^{nd} Turf Fen Road Runs parrelled to previous ones Nothing to report
- 18. Bridleway 1^{st} Broadpool Drove, leaves the village via the Fen. Nothing to report
- 19. Bridleway 2nd Broadpool Drove Nothing to report
- 20. Bridleway New Barn Drove link to 1st Broadpool Drove

Still awaiting full update from CCC. There was some confusion between Members and attendees as to what stage this installation was at. It was agreed for R Reeves to locate the agreement paperwork and the correct route map signed in May 2023 to be located and provided to the Clerks.

The Chair raised concerns over the access along the route as vehicles could get across the dyke, suggesting staggered posts so that horses and bikes can still safely get through. It was agreed that this would need to be investigated further as the landowner and Highway Authority would need to be consulted.
